Audition Requirements

- Everyone will perform a memorized musical theatre song (not from Matilda) which should reflect your vocal range and showcase the part you are auditioning for. Please bring sheet music (preferably double-sided in a binder) in the correct key for the accompanist. We will accept a pre-recorded track; however working with the accompanist is preferred. There will be a couple of audition song options with music posted on our website if you need any ideas
- Everyone will have the opportunity to perform a short reading from the show. Acting sides will be available for you to review at registration and will also be posted on our website. No memorization is necessary. Bring your best British accent!
- Everyone is required to participate in a 45 minute group dance call before or after their audition slot from 8:00-8:45 for children or 8:45-9:30 for adults (June 9 & 10) and 2:00-2:45 for children or 2:45-3:30 for adults (June 11). Please wear suitable clothes and shoes for movement and fun!
- Please arrive 10 minutes before your audition time, with a completed audition form if possible, (available on our website) to register, and allow yourself time to settle in and review your material
- We will be taking a quick photo for casting purposes
- Everyone auditioning must be double vaccinated against Covid 19. Please bring proof of vaccine status at time of registration. MMT will follow all safety protocols, masking, social distancing as per Government restrictions at the time of auditions. In an abundance of caution, and for the safety of everyone, we ask that you wear a mask at all times except during your audition
- You must be **8** years of age or older to audition
- All roles are open to any Ethnicity and will be spoken in a British accent

Call Backs:

- Successful candidates for Principal roles will be notified Saturday evening, June 11 by email, therefore, please ensure you list an accurate email address on your audition form!
- Each candidate will perform a selected song from the show which will be reviewed at the callback. Vocal selections from the show will be included in the email and will also be posted on our website
- Each candidate will participate in a short scene/s from the show. Acting sides will be available on our website. Memorization is not necessary
- ***Note:** Some roles may not require a callback, and are at the discretion of the Directorial Team

***Important – If you need to change or cancel your audition, PLEASE revise your calendar entry**

- If you are offered a role you must become a member of Meadowvale Music Theatre and pay a membership fee of \$40.00 single or \$60.00 family
- We require a firm commitment to the rehearsal schedule so **please list in detail any conflicts you are currently aware of on your audition form**
- We ask that every cast member assist us with other areas of the production. Please indicate on your audition form the areas of interest to you or your family members
